NOVEMBER PROGRAMS

11/06: David Draeger, retired U.S. Army Colonel, directs the ROTC program at Auburn High School. Colonel Draeger will share with us the benefits young men and women receive from participating in the ROTC program. He will also speak to us about ROTC in universities nationwide and the place it has in the preparing young men and women for service in the military. Butch is the host. Projector, laptop and sound system is needed.

11/13: Dr. Charles Smith is a retired physician who lost his 28 year old daughter to major depression and suicide in 2002. Teenage suicide has increased 50% since 2000. Every week, in the Rockford Register Star alone, there are teenage deaths in which the cause of death is not mentioned. I can only assume suicide is the major cause of death. Dr. Smith has founded "Group Hope" which is a support service for depression and bipolar disorder. Dr. Smith hopes to spark an innovation to bring a community of volunteers as participants in mental illness care. This. Is a very timely. Program to which you may want to bring your significant other.

11/20: Dr. Mathew has his PhD in Mechanical Engineering. Dr. Mathew's research focuses on the various causes of hip, joint and knee replacement corrosion after the replacement. His research is to develop new technologies to minimize wear and tear of implants. He is also studying ways to regenerate joint tissues to increase longevity of replacements. I have requested the presentation be made in laymen terms. The research being done at the U of I College of Medicine is at the leading edge of medical technology as they work in conjunction with major universities.

11/27: Michelle Hoffman will speak to us about "Battling the Aging Brain". We will also take a look at what is normal and what is not. Michelle will also share with us a variety of ideas for maintaining a healthy brain. Ted Plum is the host. (Projector is needed.)

AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS

Article IX: Amendment of Bylaws

Section One: These Bylaws, when amended, shall supersede and replace any existing set of constitution and bylaws. They shall become effective immediately after being adopted by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at any regular or special meeting of the club, provided the members have been notified of such action in writing or Newsletter at least ten (ten) days in advance. A quorum of 10% of the membership must be present for such action. Any changes in the bylaws will be submitted to the YMCA Executive Director, through the Senior Coordinator, for approval.

Article V: SECTION TWO: "The regular meeting on the second Tuesday in November shall be known as the Annual Meeting. where in voting for the new group of Board of Directors shall occur.

Article IV: SECTION SIX: Delete sentence #four "All checks require two signatures, one of which shall be that of the Treasurer, if available."
